***Project Discovery: Program Descriptions**

Explore four areas of interest in each 2 week session.

CAD:

Students will be introduced to practices currently being used in the field of Computer Aided Design (CAD). Students who choose CAD will have an opportunity to use the computer software, 3D Printers, and Virtual Reality tools that are all being utilized in this high tech design field. Topics covered will be Architecture, Engineering, Rapid Prototyping, and Video Game Design.

Carpentry:

Explore the basic principles of carpentry. Construct and bring home a variety of interesting, fun projects such as napkin holders, bird houses and back scratchers.

Cosmetology:

Explore career opportunities in the field of cosmetology right here at Whittier's salon. From beautiful braids to basic nail care and makeup. Students will learn nail art designs and techniques as well as application of jewels. Students will be able to bring home their own nail art wheel for display. Love makeup? Whether it's daily, formal, or dramatic special effects, students will learn basic applications as well as safety and sanitation.

Culinary Arts:

Explore how to cook and bake in Whittier's kitchen and pastry shop. Bring home delicious creations and learn about nutrition and safety in the kitchen.

Electrical:

Learn the basic principles of electricity including electrical tools and their uses and the construction of basic circuitry projects. Students will engage in constructing a small, fun project to bring home.

Graphics:

Delve into the world of digital art with programs like Adobe Illustrator, Photoshop and InDesign. Learn the basics of printing, bindery and design that every professional knows and transfer that knowledge into printed pieces of your own.

Metal Fabrication:

Have you ever wondered how giant bridges and skyscrapers stay together? Or how submarines can dive underwater so deep and not get crushed from the ocean pressure? Then come learn the basics of welding in Metal Fabrication, where we teach the people holding the world together.

Plumbing:

Welcome young plumbing explorers! Go with the flow as you learn the basics of plumbing. Practice some of the same skills that professional plumbers use every day. Gain confidence with plumbing tools.

Photography:
