Loop Courses Overview



- Program starts on Wednesday September 6th
 - Full year classes will end on June 3th*
 - Semester classes will end on January 19rd*
- Classes begin at 7:25am and end at 8:10am
- Students will be treated as high school students while they are in the building
 - Expected to follow the HHS student handbook
 - Student learning will be graded/assessed the same way our high school students are

Transportation

- HHS transportation is available each morning for students in the Loop program
 - All students will be issued a bus pass by their respective middle schools
- All students will be provided transportation back to their middle schools
 - Teachers will dismiss students at 8:10 for them to report to the bus loop
- Loop classes do not run in the event of a delayed start

Grade Reporting

- Loop courses will be visible in SchoolBrains by the end of the week
- Loop grades will appear on your students' middle school report card if they attend an HPS middle school.

What to Expect on September 6th

- All students will be directed to the Auditorium
- Students will meet members of HHS administration and Loop teachers
- Students will be dismissed from the Auditorium with their teachers and escorted to their classroom
- Teachers will walk with their classes to the bus loop for dismissal
- Members of the administration team will be present to support arrival and dismissal



What If...

- Your student will be absent?
 - Please call the High School Main Office and leave a message with the clerk.

 - Your student should return to the building and let a member of security or the secretary in the school guidance office know, we will call transportation and have someone come back and get them.
